Directions for Facilitating a Zoom Discussion

The Awakening Project is an interfaith project. Building on the experience of our student project, we are offering the following opportunity - see details below.

This project will be of interest to individuals who have a passion for social justice and are seeking ways to share the many dimensions of one's faith and the faith of others. The role of participants involves finding a few friends, or others who might be interested in the vision of this project, and facilitating a Zoom discussion.

A \$50 honorarium is being offered to individuals willing to host (organize and facilitate) a Zoom meeting - to discuss a podcast or article on *The Awakening Project* website.

The Steps for Hosting a Zoom meeting are:

- Select at least one podcast or two articles from those available on *The Awakening Project's* website - www.awakeningproject.ca.
- Prepare a summary of the podcast(s) or articles and a list of questions for discussion, similar to the questions outlined in this presentation that was prepared for a previous Zoom session. And there are summaries of other Zoom discussions listed under the 'Meetings' tab of *The Awakening Project's* website. e.g. <https://awakeningproject.ca/2020/08/26/meeting-no-4/>.
- Find 3 or more friends, or others, and ask them to listen to the podcast or read the articles you select. Ask them to review your questions - prior to the session.
- Organize a Zoom session / meeting to discuss the podcasts or articles - a Zoom code is available to allow for longer meetings – please let us know.
- Do a short report on the results of your discussion with a summary of comments on the podcasts you listened to, and suggestions for others to consider for future discussions. Do the report in PowerPoint if possible.

The facilitator of the session will receive a \$50 honorarium for organizing and facilitating a Zoom conversation as outlined above.
